- Tree thinning at St. Michael's wood



4. ALDBROUGH HYDROGEN PATHFINDER

Town and Country Planning Application

- Assessment of AHP TCPA application ongoing.
- Project description amended in application to account for demolition of brine tanks and warehouse buildings on site where AHP planned to be developed. Note - These works have been assessed in the EIA; the project team were recommended to amend the project description for clarity.

Hazardous Substances Consent Application

Assessment of HSC application ongoing.

Upcoming consent and permit applications

• Applications for marine licence (to MMO – Marine Management Organisation) and installation permit (to EA) targeted for March 2025.





5. ALDBROUGH HYDROGEN STORAGE

- We have shared a presentation by ERM on feedback from the Statutory Consultation
- This is an interim summary for the CLG and does not reflect the full content of the statutory Consultation Report which will be submitted with the DCO application
- Seismic Survey planned 2025
 - Reconnaissance surveys (on foot) end February
 - UXO survey March-April
 - Demo Day end April
 - Access to beach for seismic will require some work to the existing East Newton Cut this has been discussed with ERYC
 - Seismic survey August (after harvest)







6. HUMBER HYDROGEN PIPELINE

 Humber Hydrogen Pipeline is a collaboration between Equinor, SSE & Centrica to connect Aldbrough, Saltend & Easington with a crossing of the Humber to the South Bank

 Initial contact has been made with landowners, Ward Councillors and Parish Councils within the proposed pipeline corridor

- Ecological surveys of the route are planned for Spring 2025
- A Non-Statutory Public Consultation is planned for April-May 2025
